Brief

Upon the grant of the approval to commence academic activities by the National Universities Commission in 2005, the University Library was established to meet the teaching, learning and research needs of both the faculty members and students of the University. With its rich collections, the University Library was able to comfortably serve the University community until the population of the users began to outgrow the facilities on ground. In response to the need to have a bigger facility, General Theophilus Y. Danjuma, a retired General from the Nigerian Army in the year 2009, generously donated a purposefully-built University library with state-of-the-art facilities to the University. In recognition of the kind gesture of the donor, the Governing Council of the University approved that the new library complex be named T.Y. Danjuma Library. The Three-floor Library Complex located at the centre of the University is equipped with the basic facilities that support the teaching, learning and research activities of the University community. To ensure that the needs of the users are met, the library provides access to both print and electronic resources. The Main Library comprises the Library Administration Unit; Collection Development Department (Acquisitions Unit,

Gifts and Exchanges Unit); Technical Services Division (Cataloguing and Classification Section, Serials Section, Documents Unit); Readers' Services Division (Circulation Section, Reference Unit, Reprographic & Bindery Unit) and E-Library Unit.
