Brief

Akwa Ibom State University (AKSU) is a conventional university, operating a multi campus system. The Main Campus is located at Ikot Akpaden, Mkpata Enin Local Government Area, within the confluence of Ikot Akpaden-Eastern Obolo Road and Eket-Ikot Abasi federal highway. The other campus is located at Obio Akpa, Oruk Anam Local Government Area, along Abak-Ikot Okoro Road. The University was originally conceived as Akwa Ibom State University of Technology (AKUTECH) by the Arc. (Obong) Victor Attah led government of Akwa Ibom State in April 2003. However, in September 2010, the philosophy of establishing a conventional university, with multi-campus to meet the emerging realities and cater for greater majority of potential students in the state was initiated by the Obong (Dr.) Godswill Obot Akpabio led government. Consequently, the University commenced full academic activities in November 2010 under the pioneer Vice-Chancellor of Prof. Sunday Peters with 300 students during the 2010/2011 academic session. The pioneer faculties were: Faculties of Engineering, Natural and Applied Sciences, Oceanography and Naval Architecture, as well as Faculty of Agriculture.

Currently, the two campuses of the University play host to eight faculties. The Main Campus serves the faculties of: Education, Engineering, Biological Sciences and Physical Sciences; whereas Obio Akpa Campus serves the Faculties of: Agriculture, Arts, Management Sciences and Social Sciences. The eight faculties run undergraduates and postgraduates programmes. Moreover, the Akwa Ibom State University Library plays pivotal role of supporting the academic programmes of the university by enhancing teaching, learning, research and community services in the two campuses. This is achieved through provision of information resources and services to members of the university community. The University Library also oversees faculty/departmental libraries/resource rooms to enhance information provision and accessibility.

Brief

The University Library and Information Services is located centrally on the University Campus along Makurdi-Gboko Road. It started operations with the inception of the University in 1992 in a temporary accommodation of just one room in a bungalow apartment and a book collection of only fifty (50) volumes. It had a Higher Library Officer superintending its operations. From the initial temporary accommodation, the Library again moved to a much bigger temporary accommodation with a floor space of 454 square metres before finally moving to its present permanent accommodation on 29th August 2016. The permanent Library building has a total floor space of 3200 square metres with a Seating Capacity for 3,800 readers. The total book holding presently is 68,000 volumes and 524 journal titles with about 20,000 volumes. The Library currently has a total of 78 staff out of which 22 are Academic Librarians. The first substantive University Librarian was the late Mr. Dominic Gbakighir, who was succeeded by Mr. Akatu Agada also of blessed memory. Professor John Agada was the third substantive University Librarian after whose tenure Dr. Umbur Demekaa acted as University Librarian from 2019 until 2nd August, 2022, when Professor Innocent I. Ekoja, was appointed as substantive University Librarian. Virtual Library with 112 Internet connected desktop computers; IR Section with four high-end scanners with which over 500 theses and dissertations have been digitized and uploaded to DSpace hosted in servers in the ICT Directorate. There is plan to migrate to the cloud environment. The digitization exercise is ongoing but from 2022, graduating students are required to submit both soft and hard copies of their theses and dissertations.

Brief

The origin, growth and development of the Delta State University Library is from the defunct College of Education, Abraka, Delta State. The College, established in February 1969, metamorphosed into the Abraka Campus of the defunct Bendel State University, in 1985. The defunct Bendel State was split into Edo and Delta States on the 29th of August, 1991. On the 30th April, 1992, the Abraka Campus of the defunct Bendel State University became the Delta State University, Abraka.

The Library, being an integral part of the University, has been growing along with it. In fact, it has grown and developed to become what it is today, serving 12 Faculties. The Delta State University Library, which was domiciled in Site 2 of the University, relocated to its present (permanent) Site 3 as an Ultra-modern mega Library, in March, 2022. It is important to note at this juncture that its building in Site 2 now serves as a Branch Library. Other branches are located in three campuses: Oleh, Warri and Oghara. Under the leadership of Prof. Stephen O. Uwaifo, the Library has among other things, been restructured into the following divisions (with each division having units) rendering a wide range of services.

Following the creation of Ebonyi State from Enugu and Abia States on 1st October 1996, the Abakaliki Campus of Enugu State University of Science and Technology (ESUT) became Ebonyi State University College (EBSUC). The College was established by Ebonyi State of Nigeria (Edict No. 5 of 1998 and still affiliated to ESUT with Prof. Fidelis Ogah as the first Rector. In 1999 Ebonyi State government announced the upgrading of the University College to a full-fledged multi-disciplinary university. Brief

Imo State University was established in 1981 by the law no 4 of Imo State House of Assembly, Owerri, which was later, amended by edict no 27 of 1985 and 1988 respectively. It commenced academic activities in its temporary site at the then Madonna High School Ihitte. However, with the creation of Abia State in 1991 out of the former Imo State, the entire physical facilities and even human resources of Imo State University were ceded to Abia State. The then government of Imo State, quickly re-established and relocated Imo State University in Owerri by the law no 2 of 1992 of Imo State House of Assembly. The law establishing Imo State University also conferred on it, the responsibility to establish and maintain a library in order to help in facilitating the achievement of the tripod function of Imo State University which is teaching, learning and research. Consequently, the Imo State University library was established in 1992 and charged with the duty of acquiring, processing, organizing, preserving, retrieving and disseminating all information materials in the university. The library is strategically located in the heart of the university, and consists of one relatively large building. It has other extensions within the school which serve as faculty and departmental libraries.

The library is presently organized into five sections, these are the University Librarian's Office, the Technical Services section made up of the acquisition, cataloguing and classification unit, the Readers Services section made up of the circulation, reference, serials, archives and documentation unit as well as the branch libraries, Reprographic section made up of the bindery and photocopy unit and the Electronic & Audio-Visual Resources' Section made up of e-Library and Audio-Visual Materials Unit. The collection of the Library is both in print and non-printed formats. Its opening hours span from 8.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. from Monday to Friday.

Brief

The Kwara State University (Kwasu) Main Library named after President Muhammad Buhari was founded in 2009. It is an iconic piece of architecture that comprises indoor & outdoor reading and study spaces, seminar rooms, staff offices, Centre for innovative Teaching & research and the Centre for documentation and archiving. It houses a museum and art gallery, where various arts and crafts are being displayed for exhibitions. The library's mission is to support the University's teaching, research and community development activities through the provision of high-quality resources and

services.

From its inception in 2009 to the last quarter of 2012, the Main Library was housed in one of the Large Rooms (LR) in the College of Pure & Applied Science Building. In 2012, the Main Library moved to a twin building along the College of Agriculture & Veterinary building. On 6th July 2019, the new library complex named after President Mohammed Buhari was commissioned and was put into full operations in January 2020. Currently, the Library System consists of the Main Library at Malete and a Reading Room each at the Centre for Ecological & Environmental Research Management Studies and the Centre for Pre-Degree and Remedial Studies. The e-Library building was built through the ETF 2010 Intervention since year 2012. In 2018, the Law Library also came on board.

The Main Library has a capacity for over 80,000 volumes of books and journals. The Seating Capacity is 2,100. The outdoor reading space (enclosed and open-air) provided for 24 hours reading have a capacity for 170 students. To achieve its stated objectives, the library is presently organized into five divisions. These are the University Librarian's Office; the Collection Development Division; the Technical Services Division; the Users' Services Division; and the Electronic & Audio-Visual Resources Division. This Library started at the mini-campus on March 1, 2011 with a holding of over 850 volumes of current books, and moved to its permanent site along Igbokoda road in 2017. Presently, the library collection has grown to 47,965 volumes of books with other relevant information materials, courtesy of Philanthropic donors and UK charity organization that donated 40,000 volumes of books to Olusegun Agagu University of Science and Technology, Okitipupa, Ondo State. The acquisition policy of the library permits the purchase of at least four copies of a title for the central library and the school libraries. Donations and bequests are reviewed before they are accepted (see organizational chart). In our collections we have current books, journals, monographs, reference works, annual reports, and electronic resources, etc. Our primary audience is the staff and students of the university. The library also serves as a reference point for information acquisition for other sister institutions around us and the community in general. All bonafide users of the library are expected to register with the library and present their library pass on demand.

The library is using KOHA Library Management Software (the best practice in world knowledge management) for its operational services. Its relevance is based on system purposes, processing, workflow, and resource management that allow smooth operation. Thee-library has 125 workstations, plus two servers, three projectors, two printers and public address system. We subscribe to printed and e-academic journals, while users can access e-databases and other e-journals services like AJOL, and other aggregated databases that provide links and access to full-text articles and abstracts. Recently, the University was granted online free access by Research4Life till 2025 (AGORA, GOALI), HINARI, OARE, e-databases (ARDI), academic journals, boabab e-book catalogue, offline database including TEEAL or on CD-ROM format; and Calibre e-book resources are all available for use. The section maintains the library's technology resources, such as servers, OPACs, scanners, and other electronic devices.
